Lesson #4 - Math

Fill in the missing numbers 1-100

- Practice writing first and last name, letters, words, etc in the snow
- Count snowballs
- Make 3D shapes cube, sphere, cones, cylinders
- Fill a cup with snow and bring inside how long does it take to melt?
