NOTIFICATION OF ASBESTOS INSPECTIONS AND MANAGEMENT PLANS

Shelby City Schools has completed the required inspection of all school facilities for asbestos containing materials in response to the "Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986". After review of the inspection report we have submitted an Asbestos Management Plan to the State Department of Health for their acceptance. This Management Plan explains how we plan to respond to the asbestos that was discovered in the inspection report.

Each facility having asbestos containing building material (ACBM) was visually inspected and assessed to establish the condition of all friable known or assumed ACBM. All ACBM in our buildings is in good condition and we will continue to manage it in place, as recommended.

The complete Management Plan for all school buildings is available for public inspection during regular business hours at the district bus garage. This plan will be maintained, and updated by Scott Harvey, our asbestos "designated person". In addition, a copy of each individual building's Management Plan is available at each school's main office.

We will be conducting surveillance inspections of the ACBM in our buildings every 6 months using our designated person. We will also conduct a total reinspection of all buildings every 3 years using state-accredited personnel.
